Wednesday: Meal-5:30 Event-6:15pm

Join our family-friendly, mission-minded event to launch our fall programming: making book bags for Damou Christian Mission in Haiti, a living link supported mission (www.damou.org).

We need you—project designed for young and old, men and women. How can you be involved? Cut patterns, pin fabric, sew, decorate, fill with supplies, pack label.... Bring: clean denim (jeans, skirts, shirts; place under KIP table) or canvas, sewing machines, good scissors (bring with you and labeled to take home) and school supplies to put in finished bags. Child care through age 3 after meal.
