PORK TENT REPORT

Oops! Corrected from last week — *today* we welcome Sarah Ford, a representative from the Indiana Pork Producers, to present the check for our service at the Indiana State Fair. This was our 6th year to be blessed with this opportunity to serve. We had 161 individuals signed up for at least one shift, 41 of those worked at least 2 shifts. 30 people worked who had never signed up in the previous 5 years for a total of 220 shifts worked. 10% of the check will go to our food pantry ministry and the other 90% will go toward the church debt. Thanks to all those who participated.
