COMMUNITY GARDEN

The garden on our south lawn is a free gift to our community and church family, and we need your help to not only eat the produce, but help maintain the garden.

Ready to Harvest beans, yellow squash, head lettuce, zucchini, hot peppers, spinach, peas, swiss chard, pak choi, cabbage, cucumbers, herbs. Wash all you pick – some spraying for pests was done. **South 12 rows** of sweet corn are ready to pick. Just a reminder...pick what you'll eat fresh. The garden is not intended to be a source for bulk picking or resale.

Weeding & Watering Donate a half hour to pull weeds in the garden or in one of the flower beds. Place weeds in the compost bin east of the corn plot. Water if the garden looks dry from the available hoses. Wash all produce as some chemicals have been applied to deter pests.

Serve...at the Indiana State Fair Pork Tent for several years we have provided volunteers to work at the Pork Tent at the Indiana Stare Fair and have received \$10,000 of which \$9,000 goes on the church debt and \$1,000 to missions. We must provide 12 volunteers (age 14 and up) each day for 12 days (August 5-15, 21-22). You may serve a full day shift, only morning or afternoon and multiple times. You will receive entrance to the fair, cap, apron, and *free pork tent food*. Sign up in the south hallway. This is a wonderful way to reach, teach and serve and fellowship with new people in the church.

Picnic Shelter - Drive for One Hundred Challenge if 100 people donate \$50 this month, we can break ground and construct the shelter on the north lawn near the House of Prayer in August. The lumber has been prepared, and more than half of the cost has been donated. Tax deductible donations can be made through the offering, labeled "shelter." We've received \$439 so far.
