Ezekiel 43:1-2

Three Major Prophecies to Consider

**Big Idea – The Glory of the Lord Will Be Revealed...
All Will Know, See, and Will Bow Before the King**

Prophecy #1 – The Third Temple is Built

- **Ezekiel 43:1-5**
- **Key Point** – This main point will deal with the basic prophecy of the third temple being built where the people will see the abomination of desolation take place as well as the entrance of the second coming of Christ. This is a crucial prophecy for the second coming of Christ to become a reality.

Prophecy #2 – The Rise of a New World Leader – The Anti-Christ

- **1 John 2:18, 1 John 4:3**
- **Key Point** – The second prophecy carries with it the great understanding that during some time in the future, there will be a world leader that will arise that will eventually claim to be the Messiah and he will lead many astray.

Prophecy #3 – The End of the End – The Battle of Armageddon

- **Revelation 16:12-17** – ¹²The sixth angel poured out his bowl on the great river Euphrates, and its water was dried up to prepare the way for the kings from the East. ¹³ Then I saw three evil spirits that looked like frogs; they came out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast and out of the mouth of the false prophet. ¹⁴ They are spirits of demons performing miraculous signs, and they go out to the kings of the whole world, to gather them for the battle on the great day of God Almighty. ¹⁵ “Behold, I come like a thief! Blessed is he who stays awake and keeps his clothes with him, so that he may not go naked and be shamefully exposed.” ¹⁶ Then they gathered the kings together to the place that in Hebrew is called Armageddon. ¹⁷ The seventh angel poured out his bowl into the air, and out of the temple came a loud voice from the throne, saying, “It is done!”
- **Key Point** – The final prophecy is the most overwhelming prophecy as we begin looking at the final battle between good and evil that is described as Armageddon in Revelation 16:16.
